School Improvement Council Parent Representative Election

*Election Dates: **September 4-8, 2014***

This is an election to choose three parent representatives to the MMS School Improvement Council (SIC). The SIC is an advisory council to the principal that is focused on school improvement. It is made up of parent, teacher, and community representatives. The principal serves as an ex-officio member.

There are a total of five parent candidates running for the three vacant parent representative positions on the SIC. The candidates receiving the three highest vote totals will be elected to the SIC for a two-year term. (If the parent will not have a student enrolled in MMS next year, he/she will be elected for a one-year term only.)
