Increase the Effectiveness of Your School-Family-Community Partnerships

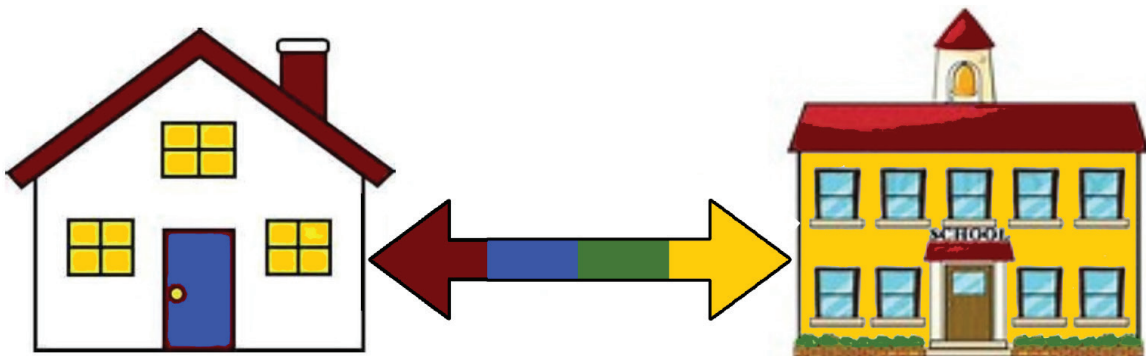
All SC K-12 public schools with a poverty index of at least 60% are eligible to apply for free, ongoing professional development and technical assistance from the Carolina Family Engagement Center.

CFEC liaisons will work side-by-side with up to 24 schools for four years beginning in fall 2019 to develop, implement, and evaluate individualized school family engagement plans that meet federal, state, and district requirements and support existing school climate and student achievement goals.

Partnership advantages include:

- **High quality professional development and technical assistance designed to meet the capacity-building needs of school personnel and all types of families**
- **Focus on reaching families facing multiple challenges to engagement**
- **Emphasis on using family engagement as a tool to meet existing achievement and school climate goals.**
- **Sufficient time to develop relationships and achieve and document results**
- **Access to expertise and support from University of SC College of Education and CFEC community partners**
