



EOC Has Assessment Resources for Students and Families of 11th Graders

With assistance from ACT, the SC Education Oversight Committee (EOC) has developed resources for school districts and schools to use to inform students and parents of 11th graders about the changes in testing that will begin this year. This school year marks the beginning of important changes in state testing for all 11th graders in South Carolina. The High School Assessment Program (HSAP) will no longer be given. Instead, students in 11th grade will take two assessments: The ACT, a college and career readiness assessment and WorkKeys®, which measures essential workforce skills.
