



South Carolina ASCD Seeks Applicants for Its Annual Whole Child Award

South Carolina ASCD sponsors the annual Whole Child Award program in support of ASCD Worldwide and The Whole Child Initiative. This program seeks to identify schools in South Carolina that have created a school culture with programs that exemplify one or more of the five tenets of The Whole Child Initiative: Healthy, Safe, Supported, Challenged, and Engaged.



Schools applying for the award are required to submit a completed application along with supporting evidence to SC ASCD according to program timelines. Applications will be reviewed by a selection committee to determine which schools should receive the recognition and a \$1,000 grant, given for the purpose of implementing other goals related to one or more of the tenets of The Whole Child Initiative.
